Scholarship Guidelines & Application Form

1. Introduction: The Bemidji Areas Arts Endowment is a component fund of Northwest Minnesota Foundation. The mission of BAAE is to, "create a community in which the arts flourish and enhance our lives."
2. What types of scholarships are available?
 - a. The Everett Wilimek Endowment for Orchestral String Studies was established by his family to provide scholarships for young people in the Bemidji area, ages 8-15, to study violin, viola, cello or bass, including but not limited to scholarship money for lessons, training, and instrument rental.
3. How are grant applications reviewed?
 - a. The advisory board of the BAAE will review all applications and advise the Northwest Minnesota Foundation and the Wilimek family of its recommendations. If approved, the NMF will act on the BAAE recommendation. Recipients will be notified on or before May 1st, 2019.
4. What are the grant review criteria?
 - a. Criteria for reviewing the scholarship applications will focus on the seriousness with which the student approaches their music study as evidenced by the written statements on the application form.
